

Why Entrepreneurialism?

Reframe entrepreneurship research by moving the focus from the individual agency of entrepreneurs to the ideology of entrepreneurialism and its effect on society

Entrepreneurship

- Object of study: Individual choice of pursuing market opportunities
- Approach: Micro functional-behavioral
- Temporality: Focus on how novel futures break with the past

Entrepreneurialism

- Object of study: Societal discourse that defines legitimate agency for change
- 2 Approach: Socio-historical hermeneutic
- Temporality: Understand the present in relationship to past and future

Recruiting Process


PhD fellows were recruited in 2023 and in 2024.

- 168 applicants from 37 countries applied, with 16% from Denmark.
- Candidates were evaluated by independent assessment committees; 9 were invited for interviews.
- We hired 5 PhD fellows, 2% of total applicants.

Postdocs were recruited in 2024.

- 56 applicants from 23 countries applied, with 14% from Denmark.
- The independent assessment committee shortlisted 8 candidates who were invited for a workshop at CBS. In-person interviews were held after the workshop.
- We hired 4 postdocs with different starting dates, 7% of total applicants.


